CORPORAL PUNISHMENT

The use or threat of corporal punishment shall not be permitted. Corporal punishment is defined as inflicting physical hurt upon a student in order to punish him/her for misconduct.

Reasonable and necessary force against students is permitted only:

- 1. To quell a disturbance threatening physical injury to others.
- 2. To obtain possession of weapons or other dangerous objects.
- 3. For the purpose of self-defense.
- 4. For protection of persons or property.
