

NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL TEXTBOOKS

- A. The Chariho Regional School District will provide textbooks to non-public school students in accordance with Rhode Island General Law 16-23-2, i.e.
 - 1. Textbooks will be provided on a loan basis and free of charge to resident students of the district whose parents/guardians so request in a format provided for by the school principal.
 - 2. The textbooks requested will be on the approved list published by the Commissioner of Education.

- B. In addition, the district will provide, on a loan basis and free of charge, textbooks in other subject areas that are used in the Chariho schools, provided that extra copies are available and not in use by students enrolled in the Chariho schools, and that the provision of such texts not incur additional cost to the district.

- C. Textbooks are to be returned to the district by the borrower. Lost books, or those damaged to the extent of not being reusable as determined by the school principal, are to be paid for by the borrower.

- D. Non-return of textbooks and/or failure to pay for lost or damaged books will result in non-provision of books in the ensuing years until such time as payments due are made.

- E. The superintendent will insure that persons concerned with this policy be informed of it.
