EMPLOYEE DRESS CODE

All employees are expected to dress professionally and wear the Chariho identification badge. Men will wear closed-toe footwear; sweaters; tucked dress shirts, collared shirts or turtlenecks; and are encouraged to wear ties. Women will wear dresses; skirts; pant suits; slacks; blouses; blazers or sweaters. No employee will wear short, low-cut, midriff-baring or tight clothing; jeans; sweatshirts; hats; shorts; T-shirts; white athletic sneakers or flip-flops; warm-up suits; and other similar casual and athletic attire, unless appropriate for the employee's assignment. Those employees required to wear uniforms must do so.

Dress-down days may be allowed with administrative permission. Proper dress-down identification must be worn. Casual dress will be the norm for these days. Items prohibited above may not be worn on dress-down days, with the exception of appropriate, well-kept jean slacks, sneakers, and sweatshirts.
