

HOURLY EMPLOYEES AND STIPEND POSITIONS

The Chariho Regional School Committee, in complying with the Fair Labor Standards Act, acknowledges that hourly employees who engage in other than strictly volunteer co-curricular and coaching activities must be paid overtime if their total time spent on behalf of the District (regular work hours plus co-curricular/coaching) exceeds forty (40) hours in any given work week. The School Committee, due to budget constraints that would be caused by such a situation, will no longer hire its hourly employees for co-curricular and coaching positions that are paid by stipend.
