PREGNANCY COUNSELING

It shall be the policy of the Chariho Regional School District that the matter of pregnancy counseling be handled in the following manner:

Any student who believes that she is pregnant and confides this information to any staff member shall be immediately referred to the school nurse.

Upon receiving such a referral, the following procedures will be implemented:

- 1. Student will be counseled to confide in her parents/guardians. This will be the case regardless of age. In the case of a student under the age of eighteen, if the student refuses, the nurse or counselor will contact the parent/guardian.
- 2. Parental involvement will be required for those under eighteen, but will be encouraged for all. The nurse will insure that the parents/guardians are providing medical evaluation and, if appropriate, prenatal care. If this is not happening, the nurse will treat it as a case of medical neglect and will pursue with the proper authorities.
- 3. Medical confirmation of the pregnancy is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. With permission from the parent/guardian, high school students may use the nurse to facilitate care.
- 4. The district will use the services of all its health and human services staff to provide an adapted educational plan for both pre and postnatal students.

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
