Lunch Application Clarification

It was recently brought to our attention that our communication about this year's <u>Lunch program</u> was unclear. Please note the following;

- Free lunch is available to all students, regardless of household income status until 12/30/2020 (or until USDA funds run out) **No application is necessary to access the free lunch through 12/30/2020**
- We are encouraging all families to apply for the meal program because the USDA may review our applications to verify our community is aware of and using the application process.
- If you have applied, thank you. A denial letter does not affect your access to free lunch through
 12/30/2020 (or until USDA funds run out).
- If your household situation changes, please let us know so we can update your application on file.
- Effective 10/5/2020 the distance learner lunch distribution at the High School will be open 9:15 am to 9:45 am. We have found that the majority of pick-ups are happening at that time. If this creates a concern, please let our Chartwell's team member know by emailing leigh.rainey@compass-usa.com.
