**Happy New Year!** It is our sincerest hope that everyone had an opportunity to relax and refresh over the winter break.

We are ready to begin 2021. Our schedule is as follows:

<u>January 4-8</u> will be District-wide Virtual Learning Days. Students will all learn from

home. Please note this is not an extension of the winter break, it is a buffer that ensures we return to in-person learning with minimized exposure to risk from the break.

As a reminder, <u>Wednesdays</u> are early release days. Live instruction ends at 11:30 am for CHS/CMS/CALA and 12:45 pm for elementary schools.

Distance Learning Families can access Grab and Go lunches every Monday, Wednesday and Friday <u>9-10:30 am at Chariho Regional High School.</u>

As a reminder, any family who chooses to move to full Distance Learning as their learning scenario may do so during the month of December and January without losing their in-person seat.

We have set a goal to return to District-Wide in-Person learning on **January 11th** (for those that have chosen that option). This date is subject to change. In making this decision we will work with the RI Department of Health, examine our positive cases, our ability to staff, and review local data. I will continue to update you as necessary. We continue to be thankful for your understanding, support, and cooperation during this very challenging time.



# **Daily Self Check Requirement**

**Parents and Guardians**: As a reminder, all in-person learners must have a **daily self-check** completed **every day** prior to leaving the house. Any student who participates in athletics, extracurricular activities, or receives services at school will also need the daily self-check completed. This is a requirement from our state as well as part of our **District Attendance Policy**. Any family that does not consistently complete this daily self-check will be required to move to distance learning. It is imperative that we ensure everyone is healthy when attending school. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated while we work to keep our school communities safe.

RIDOH recommends <u>anyone who is a close contact</u> schedule a COVID-19 test before returning to school.
