March 2021 E-Update

We are now preparing for Trimester 3 and Quarter 4. It is hard to believe it is already March! At this time, we will be requesting that our Middle school, High school, and Elementary school families determine if they would like to change their learning scenario for the fourth quarter/third trimester. Action is only needed if



you want to make changes to your current learning scenario. If you choose to make a change, either from distance learning to in-person learning or in-person learning to distance learning, you must complete the registration link for each child, using their designated school google form linked below, no later than March 8th by noon for elementary school students and March 9th by noon for middle school and high school students.

Based on the new registrations for in-person learning we will need to determine if we can remain in a full 5 day a week open scenario or make a shift to our plan for grades 6-12. As you know we have guidance from DOH as it relates to spacing in classrooms and our transportation is limited due to the bus guidelines. If you requested transportation but have the ability to drive your child/children we ask that you do so in order to free up space for families who need the bus every day. Our goal would be to determine the plan for grades 6-12 for quarter 4, no later than April 1st to allow middle school and high school families to plan accordingly. Grades PK- 5 per RIDE will be prioritized to remain full in person every day.

<u>Please note</u> that if your child is registered for in-person learning the only time they should be accessing distance learning is if they have symptoms, are in quarantine/isolation, their class/district/school is placed on distance learning per the district/school administration or the child was registered for DL as their learning scenario.
