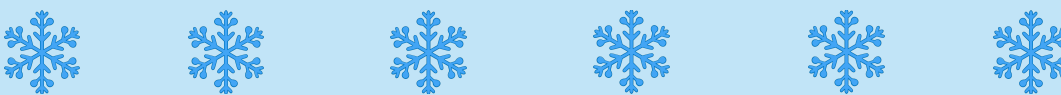
Mentoring is a special partnership between two people based on a mutual commitment to the mentoring process, including common goals/expectations of the partnership, mutual trust and respect. Mentoring is both a "get and give" experience with the goal of providing a rich and rewarding experience for both the mentor and mentee.

The mission of the CHILL Chariho Mentoring Program is to provide at-risk (i.e., academically, behaviorally, and socially) 5th-12th grade students, currently enrolled at Chariho Regional Middle School (CMS), Chariho Regional High School (CHS), or the Chariho Alternative Learning Academy (CALA), with individual and group mentoring experiences focused on building positive and supportive personal connections thoughtfully designed to inspire learners to become leaders.
