

Weather Decisions

Families have asked how the call for Distance Learning (DL) is made versus a no school day. Weather decisions are never easy and every weather event is different. We monitor the conditions and receive input from EMA directors, local officials DPW/Police, the bus company and our colleagues across South County. When schools are closed (no DL), these days are required to be made up at the end of the year. Districts may only use up to 5 distance learning days during the school year.



As a reminder, we have enabled our school text messaging feature for emergency notifications. In order to participate in this service, you must first opt in by sending a text message of Y or Yes to our school's short code number 67587. Individuals who have not opted in will not receive text messages. You can opt out at any time by texting STOP to the messages.
