While our Virtual Learning plan has been approved by RIDE, it is important to note that RIDE has added requirements for virtual learning that differ from what students, parents, and families experienced over the last couple of years. As a result, it is more likely that the District will utilize traditional school cancellation days and may only consider utilizing virtual learning days if the snowstorms/inclement weather closures go beyond 2 or 3 days.
