2023 Advanced Placement Scores Exhibit Excellence



We are proud to acknowledge that Chariho High School's Advanced Placement exam performance was very strong, with most AP subject areas outperforming both state and global data. This was seen across both the Humanities and STEM fields. One hundred and seventy-five students took the AP Exams this year, and Chariho High School administered 265 total exams. Seventy-three percent of all Chariho AP students earned a score of 3 ("Qualified") or higher on their AP exam. A score of "3" or" Qualified" means that a student has proven him/herself capable of doing the work of an introductory-level course in a particular subject at college. Additionally, twenty-six Chariho students earned "AP Scholar Awards", this award is given to students who receive a score

of 3 or higher on three or more AP exams. Andrea Spas, Principal of Chariho High School states, "It is a big accomplishment to meet the rigor of proficiency on an AP exam. We are very proud of the hard work our students and teachers put into meeting the high expectations of AP performance. This is a testament to the strong study and work habits of our students as well as the high-quality instruction by our teachers. This is a huge achievement for our students and teachers. We would like to highlight the following exemplary AP performances...".

- 86% of our **AP Biology** students scored a 3 or better on their AP exam
- 87% of our AP Art History students scored a 3 or better on their AP exam
- 89% of our **AP Chemistry** students scored a 3 or better on their AP exam
- 97% of our AP English Literature students scored a 3 or better on their AP exam
- 100% of our AP Calculus students scored a 3 or better on their AP exam
- 100% of our AP Drawing and AP 3D Art students scored a 3 or better on their AP exam
- 100% of our AP Spanish students scored a 3 or better on their AP exam

We continue to be proud of the hard work of our students and teachers. The outstanding performance on the Advanced Placement exams of our students, reflects the high-quality education our students are receiving. We want to congratulate all of them on a job well done!
