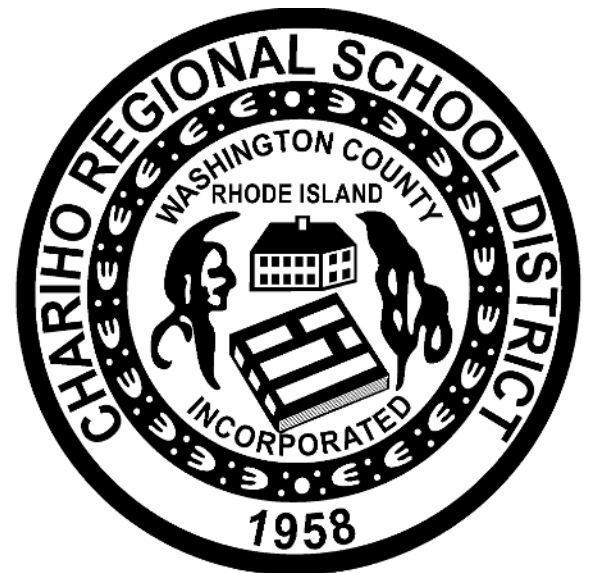

START HERE (REGISTRATION WILL OPEN SATURDAY MARCH 23rd)

1. eRegistration [form](#)
2. Locator Card from Town Hall-Signed original
3. Child's Birth Certificate, adoption decree or passport
4. Current record of immunizations signed by a physician. (Except for medical or religious reasons, State Law requires that students must be properly immunized before they can attend school.)
5. Evidence of child's most recent physical exam, dental exam and lead screening date and results.
6. A certified copy of the most recent court order identifying each parent's respective award of physical custody, if applicable.
7. A copy of the students' IEP or 504 plan, if applicable.
8. Copies of parent/guardian licenses (front and back)

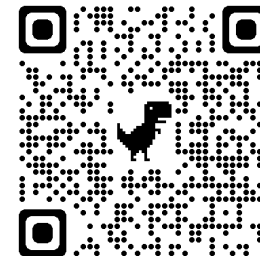

THE LANGUAGE OF BEHAVIORS: UNDERSTANDING CHALLENGING BEHAVIORS

How do we evaluate what a child's behavior is trying to communicate. Behavior is a form of communication which is especially important. Children have limited means of expressing themselves or have neither the developmental level nor psychological capacities to "tell us" how they are doing and how we are doing with them. 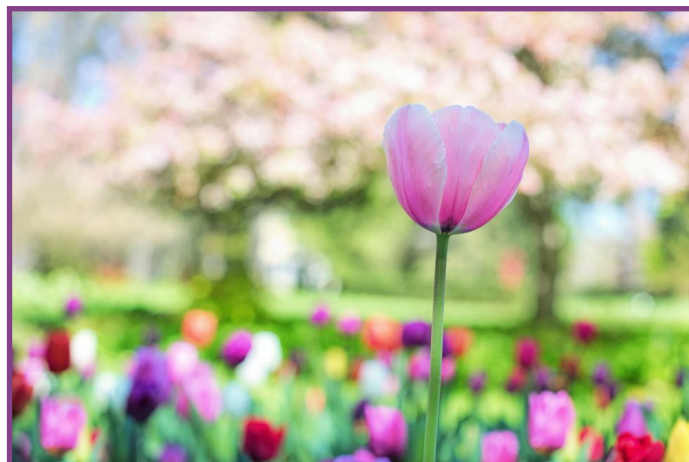
