RICAS Updates - PNP Window Opens, TAMs Posted

The **Personal Needs Profile (PNP) Initial Window for RICAS** opened Monday in PearsonAccessNext (PAN) and will extend through February 18.

Test coordinators now are able to update students' accommodations and accessibility features in PAN. This initial window focuses primarily on accommodations assignment for students who need paper format tests in accordance with their IEP/504 plans. Paper tests assigned to students within this February 7 through February 18 window will *automatically* be shipped to schools for the initial materials shipments for each content area, along with pre-printed Student ID Labels. Test coordinators are also encouraged to complete as much of the computer-based accommodations and accessibility features assignments as possible during this initial window.

An extended PNP window does last until the start of the state testing windows, but please note that any paper tests assigned after February 18 will need to be ordered separately through the RICAS Service Center (starting March 16 when that system opens) - they will not be shipped with that initial shipment - and will not include pre-printed Student ID Labels.

The PNP windows are also posted in the RICAS section of www.ride.ri.gov/Assessment-Schedules.

PDF versions of the **Spring 2022 RICAS Test Administrator's Manuals for Computer-Based Testing (CBT) and for Paper-Based Testing (PBT)** have been posted in both the Test Coordinator's section and the Test Administrator's section on RIDE's Assessment Manuals page at www.ride.ri.gov/Assessment-Manuals. The TAMs and the Spring 2022 Test Coordinator's Manual (TCM) were also posted on the RICAS Resource Center website on Friday, February 4.

Paper copies of RICAS TAMs will also be shipped to schools as part of the initial ELA paper materials shipment to be delivered on March 16. For more information and dates, please review the RICAS TC Training webinar (found at www.ride.ri.gov/Assessment-Manuals).
