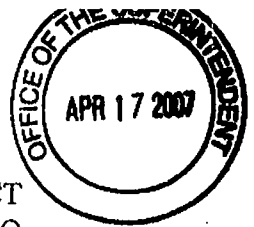




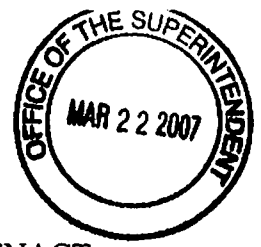

- WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Hopkinton endorses and supports the financing of improvements to the Switch Road Campus of the Chariho Regional School District (the "Project");
- WHEREAS, in order to undertake and complete the Project, there would be a need for the Chariho Regional School District to issue bonds and notes in an amount not to exceed \$26,000,000;
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Town that the principal of, redemption premium and interest on the bonds and notes be borne by the member towns in equal amounts, with each member town paying one-third. NOW THEREFORE, BE IT
- RESOLVED: that the Town hereby memorializes the General Assembly to enact legislation authorizing the Chariho Regional School District to issue bonds and notes in an amount not to exceed \$26,000,000 to finance improvements to the Switch Road campus and amending the Chariho Regional School District Enabling Act to provide that the principal of, redemption price and interest on the bonds and notes issued for the project will be borne by the member towns in equal amounts, with each member town paying one-third of the cost. 




