I don't know that anyone would have predicted that Chariho High School would be ranked #3 in Rhode Island, behind Classical High School and Barrington High School, by the US News and World Report. I couldn't be prouder of our hard-working students, faculty and staff, who are guided by our strong and persistent leaders. On behalf of our students, I thank our parents and guardians, community members, and elected officials who understand the importance of high expectations, coupled with support and accountability.

Graduation will be held on Friday, June 8 at 7:00 PM at The Ryan Center at the University of Rhode Island. There's plenty of room for everyone; no tickets are necessary. Everyone is welcome!

Early in the next school year, we will develop a new five-year district strategic plan. This important document guides the development of school improvement plans, as well as the formation of the budget. Please reserve the evenings of September 26, October 10 and October 25. Kirsten LaCroix of the Center for Leadership and Educational Equity will facilitate this work. All, including students, are invited to participate.

Next year's school calendar brings several significant changes. First, students will start school on the Tuesday after Labor Day. Second, the February vacation as we have known it will no longer exist. The Thanksgiving Recess will be three, instead of two days. Finally, we will not close school for parent-teacher conferences. Parents and Guardians may request a conference any time; a meeting will be scheduled within five school days.
