From your Superintendent...

I appreciate the support of the community for a high-quality, rigorous public education. The vote in the all-day budget referendum, with 589 in favor and 201 opposed, was evidence of that support. On behalf of every one of our students, I thank you.

By now, you should have received a post card via US Mail reminding you to register for transportation (if it's needed) for the 2018-2019 school year; even if you don't register now and find that your child(ren) need transportation in the future, you may register then. This process has allowed us to more efficiently develop routes for our buses and is highly reliant upon all families who need transportation registering for it by June 15. This year, we were able to remove two buses, with related costs of about \$160,000, from our fleet. You may register at www.chariho.k12.ri.us; assistance is available at 364-7575. Several new and exciting opportunities are available for next year's upperclassmen. First, we were awarded a grant to offer Mandarin Chinese.
