

Chariho School Committee Certified Staff Negotiation Subcommittee Mediation
Regular Session Minutes
October 20, 2012

Subcommittee Members Present: Chair Robert Cardozo, Deborah Carney and Alternate Gregory Kenney. Absent: Georgia Ure and Alternate Amanda Blau.

Administrator Present: Superintendent Barry Ricci and Assistant Superintendent Carol Blanchette. Also in attendance: Attorney for the School Committee Jon Anderson and School Committee Clerk Donna Sieczkiewicz.

I. Meeting Call to Order

Chair Robert Cardozo called the meeting of the Chariho School Committee Negotiation Subcommittee, which was held at NEARI in Cranston, to order at 12:15 PM.

II. Approval of Regular Session Minutes

Deborah Carney made a motion, seconded by Gregory Kenney and it was VOTED: To approve the regular session minutes of October 16, 2012. In favor: Unanimous.

III. Executive Session

Deborah Carney made a motion, seconded by Gregory Kenney and it was VOTED: That the Certified Staff Negotiation Subcommittee go into executive session and close the meeting to the public under the authority of R.I. General Laws Section 42-46-5(a)(2) for the purpose of work sessions pertaining to collective bargaining. In favor: Unanimous.

VI. Disclosure of Executive Session Votes

Chair Cardozo reported that three votes were taken in executive session. The first vote, approval of executive session minutes of October 16, 2012, was unanimous with 3 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstentions with Carney, Cardozo and Kenney voting in favor.

The second vote, pertaining to certified staff negotiations, was unanimous with 3 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstentions with Carney, Cardozo and Kenney voting in favor.

The third vote, to return to open session, was unanimous with 3 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstained with Carney, Cardozo and Kenney voting in favor.
